## 7. Correspondence / Reports

## 7.1 Report of the Drainage Superintendent/Project Manager dated

Frank Jonkman

From the Drainage Superintendent's report came a few points to highlight:

- 1) The Drainage Superintendent elaborated on the status of the Bardawill Pumphouse repairs required; its historical function and capacity of the system in general. As a result of this failure, the system is undergoing a change in methodology, including a new valve system for intake of water for irrigation, with a pump system to handle the pumping off of water. Delivery of the valve I expected no earlier than June 22<sup>nd</sup>. The pump component is still at the quotation stage but will be installed later in the summer.
- 2) It was noted that landowners receiving a new crossing as part of the irrigation component of the Canal Improvement Project are satisfied with the new installations.
- 3) The second bridge to be replaced in BWG will follow a similar schedule of activity as the Line 5 Bridge, however, the start and completion timeline is under the engineering dept's purview.

The Springdale Church and members of its congregation are seeking some timeline estimates though, as it is committing to certain events throughout the year. It was requested that the Church be notified of reconstruction timelines as soon as possible to facilitate event bookings.

4) Councilor Lamb inquired about the suspected 75 year storm that took place over the weekend and its effects on the Morris Road ditch and surrounding area.

The Board was advised that the intent is to undergo a Section 76 report in accordance with the Drainage Act for this area and a subsequent Section 78 to allow the Board to potentially undertake to improve the area in question. It is a process and will not occur overnight but it is being addressed.

- 5) TOK inquired as to the dredging status and the Drainage Superintendent reiterated that the dredging work related to the Canal Improvement Project is complete on the south side.
- 6) A member inquired as to the status of the County Road and repairs to the road thereof. It was advised by the Drainage Superintendent that the Town is involved in a maintenance agreement for County Road 8, and therefore the Town is responsible for the maintenance of the road.

There is no obligation for the Town or County to resurface or improve this road; however the Project is responsible for repairing the portion of the road which is damaged as a result of the Canal Improvement Project. This work though, will only address the northerly or westbound lane of road, but not the entire road allowance.

7) The potential for a trail system was addressed. The Drainage Superintendent is attending the Active Transportation Committee meeting this evening and will have more information as to the intentions of the Town/Committee at the next board meeting.

The Chairman did note that he supports the proposed trail through the Holland Marsh, as it speaks to mirroring healthy food grown in the Marsh to healthy lifestyles.

No other issues were raised on this item.

#### **Drainage Superintendent Activities**

1. Main Drain

a. River levels are being maintained at seasonal levels.

i. Control panels and related wiring for dredger remain to be installed.

#### 2. Bardawill Pumphouse

- a. Failure of the 40hp pump, notification sent to Board members 02/05/12.
- b. A stainless knife gate valve has been installed (18/07/12) and inlet water will be controlled from this point for the central portion of the Main Drain.
- c. Continued conversations and meetings regarding a replacement pump, the existing pumps will be replaced with a single unit with the same capacity as required in the report for the pumping station.

#### 3. Small Scheme

- Continued discussion with LSRCA regarding maintenance on the Morris Road Drain.
- b. Continued discussions with BWG Engineering regarding flooding issues (09/06/12) along Edward Street and Bingham Street.
- c. Discussions with design consultants to determine the suitability of the Morris Road Drain to accept water from the South East Arterial Road and future development along such.
- d. Discussions with KSAL to initiate Section 76 Varying original assessments for maintenance and Section 78 Improving, upon examination and report of engineer; an engineering firm will need to be appointed under the Drainage Act to continue with further analysis and design.
- e. Discussions with Riverstone Environmental to source a material to be applied in the Small Scheme to eliminate Mill Foil, an invasive aquatic species which is impacting the pumping operations.

#### 4. Holland River Drain

a. Debris and log jam will need to be removed from bridge at Hwy 9.

#### 5. LSRCA

a. Continued conversations / meetings regarding the continuation of tree planting along the Main Drain and areas of the HMDSCIP.
